

Stand strong in Christ's Faith for there's no hope in temporal sovereignty.

I understand the Constitution is supposed to be the people's right of temporal sovereignty on the one hand, but as a believer in Christ I find on the other hand I must also take in consideration the possibility that it may have run its course and served its purpose in the Divine Plan at this point in time... then those professing to be true believers (and this message applies for believers of all nations as well), will be faced with their greatest test.

It is prophesied the Beast out of the land will rise and exercise the power of the first Beast over all those on the earth... and the people will not be able to stand against it (except the Faithful in Christ)... and this country, as many others, have been usurped and assimilated into the Beast and Babylon System. The corrupt ruling elitists have nearly achieved the unified cause of their endeavors/undertakings... being their "Great Work"... aka their "New and One World Order"... there may be some who think they can change that and take back what they had... but do you really think so?

The Prophecies of God's WORD however, will come to pass down to the last detail whether they are believed or not... and it is only through the Power of Christ's Spirit that we believers can overcome. If you claim to be Christ's you should know that. The corrupt ruling elitists of the Beast and Babylon System know these things too and know their time is short, so with all their efforts to secure a continuance in the temporal, with their very survival being at stake, it's all or nothing for them in a stand against the True God of Heaven and His Christ whose time is now at hand. If we profess Jesus Christ as Savior be Spiritually prepared believing in Him that you be found in His Rest, so you'll be accounted among the Faithful in Him and worthy of His escape.

The Mighty Angel standing on the sea and on the earth says that "there should be time no longer"... see Rev 10:5-7

AS BELIEVERS WE MUST STAND IN CHRIST'S FAITH AND SPIRIT TO BE SAVED, AND IT SORROWS ME TO SAY THAT CONSTITUTIONALISM CAN'T DO THAT... THE GREATER CHOICE HERE IS TO STAND IN THE FAITH OF JESUS AND HIS SPIRIT OF TRUTH UNTO A BETTER HOPE BY BELIEVING IN HIS PROMISES, AND HIS HEAVENLY KINGDOM/COUNTRY.

Are you a Christian who is believing and practicing, and who is walking after the higher application of the Spirit of the Law of Life so being awake in the Faith and Valid to Christ's New Covenant?... or just claiming to be one and not believing and practicing after the Spirit but only practicing after the things of the letter of the law of sin and death, and/or after the doctrines of men, and/or walking after the fleshly/earthly/temporal/vain things of this world so being asleep to the Faith and invalid to Christ's New Covenant.

When the True and Living God made the temporal creation He framed it on and according to His WORD, and it is that WORD that the two Covenants are based on... in the scriptures we find that the establishment of Christ's New Covenant supersedes the Old Covenant... and in the Divine Plan, God provided through his Son the Christ, a change in both the Covenant and the Testament, of which Jesus is the Mediator of this New and better Covenant and Testament which is established on better promises... and by which the people of God are unified as one body, whether they be Jew or Gentile both are now made one, and both are the Faithful in Christ, to include those of the Faithful before Christ came into the world and those Faithful after He returned to the Father in Heaven... this is not a "replacement theology" but would be more correctly understood as an "inclusion theology", as a

provision to God's Divine Plan... the more you come to understand His Divine Plan the more you will come to marvel at the greatness of it.

It is understood that it is by the Grace of Christ that we are saved, but it doesn't stop there... the believer being born again through His Grace is to continue on with the instruction of "go and sin no more", and then should come to the realization of the need to receive the Holy Ghost and to stand validly in His New Covenant maturing in His Faith and the Spirit. Professing belief in Christ must also be accompanied with living and doing the things that you learn and come to know are of Christ's teachings on how we are to be, which are "works of righteous deeds" that believers who have been saved and changed from a life of sinfulness are supposed to be doing with the help of the Holy Ghost. The Apostle James tells us "Faith without works is dead"... he is not referring to the "works of the law" here... but he is referring to works in the sense and application of believing is doing/practicing what you preach/walking in the Faith after the Spirit/living the Testimony of Christ in keeping and fulfilling his WORD/Commandments, so we can keep His New Covenant in a higher and better way that we might receive the Promise of the Spirit through Faith... this is not the same as keeping the Commandments by the old testament ordinances and precepts being the "works of the law"... which is not of Grace through Faith in Christ, and of which Jesus abolished for us under his New Covenant.

If one lives by the old it only leads<sup>2</sup> to death because of sin, for it concludes all under sin, resulting in the perdition of the soul in ruin/lack... or if one lives in a corrupt manner so as to hold and practice false beliefs through false spirits of Antichrist and/or in mystery Babylon's secret circle teachings which makes a way for the allowance of partaking in deeds of sinfulness/wickedness/iniquities it will only again lead to death resulting in a paradox for the soul in ruin/lack... and in this we see the effect of the Power of the CROSS of CHRIST which is the WORD of GOD and the SWORD of the SPIRIT.

It is the Holy Spirit that can empower and uplift our minds and consciousness to be in Unity/Oneness in Christ... and it is the weight of the bonds of temporal mindedness set upon the things of this temporal world, which is the workings of evil spirits trying to keep us oppressed, confused, distracted, and in ignorance to the Higher Spiritual Truths in Christ that could free us from the bondage of this world. As the Apostle Paul tells us "we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of darkness of this world, and against spiritual wickedness in the high places". The Holy Spirit gives us the armor of God so we are able to stand against the wiles/tricks/deceptions of the evil one.

If we now live by Faith in the New Covenant of Christ it leads<sup>2</sup> us to life everlasting through the promise of His Spirit unto a heavenly reward for the soul... and only Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life, and no one can come to the Father but by Him... and Jesus and the Father are One... and in Him is the Wisdom of God and His Mysteries of the depth and the riches revealed to us by His Spirit of which is written the eye has not seen, nor ear has heard, neither has entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for them that love Him.

Rev 21:7

"He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son." (*and daughter/children*)

Again I say put your hope and trust in Christ's Faith and Spirit, and not in the temporal things of this world, and don't look back! That is, do not return to your unbelief before you came to know Christ!... And now, if the Holy Ghost dwells within you, and you have put on the garments and been clothed with virtues of the Spirit, through whom you have been made in a valid state of mind/consciousness to the New Covenant of Christ, DO NOT return to the old invalid state which would put you in danger

of that which is not forgivable... if you should reject the Holy Ghost. If you're still struggling with sin and backsliding get serious and stand upright before Jesus and seek God's Mercy, for Grace does not cover those who are backsliding. If you were baptized with the Holy Ghost you are also baptized with Fire... do not rebel against God for chastisements, for it is necessary for His undisciplined children to undergo such, of which they will then come to know and understand His Mercifulness and Forbearance.

The Apostles and the followers of Christ of the early Church times practiced and exemplified just what it means to live as a true believer in Christ while in this temporal world, and many of them also exemplified what it means to die as a true believer in Christ.

However we in Christ who are still in this world at the Last Trump...

In remembrance of Jesus, the Christ, our Savior, who is One with the True and Living God and who is God, and His Holy Spirit speaking through His Faithful servants... Remember these Words given to us:

#### Mark 8:34-38

34 - And when he had called the people unto him with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

35 - For whosoever will save his life shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it.

36 - For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?

37 - Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

38 - Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.

(In Matthew this verse also says "... and then he shall reward every man according to his works.")

#### Luke 17:29-37

29 - But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed them all.

30 - Even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of man is revealed.

31 - In that day, he which shall be upon the housetop, and his stuff in the house, let him not come down to take it away: and he that is in the field, let him likewise not return back.

32 - Remember Lot's wife.

33 - Whosoever shall seek to save his life shall lose it; and whosoever shall lose his life shall preserve it.

34 - I tell you, in that night there shall be two men in one bed; the one shall be taken, and the other shall be left.

35 - Two women shall be grinding together; the one shall be taken, and the other left.

36 - Two men shall be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.

37 - And they answered and said unto him, Where, Lord? And he said unto them, Wheresoever the body is, thither will the eagles be gathered together.

#### Luke 21:34-36

34 - And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares.

35 - For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth.

36 - Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.

Rev 3:8,10

8 - I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.

10 - Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

*This suggests and alludes to an escape of some form Jesus is providing for the Faithful who BELIEVE Him...*

*Do you still disbelieve? That is, not believing there will be an Escape/to be Caught Up/to be Seized/to be Taken/to be Transported/a Carrying Away/a Spiriting Away/Aramaic- Natchatuf /Greek- Arpageso /Latin- Rapiemur, which is where we get the word Rapture from. If the Latin language was still in common use today then Latin Bibles would be more used, and that verse in 1 Thessalonians 4:17 where it says "caught up" in English Bibles would be translated as "rapiemur" in Latin, which means "caught up"! Don't you know that Latin versions of the Bible do exist, such as the Latin Vulgate Bible?... So that term actually is in the Bible!*

*You disbelievers may want to rethink these things if you are able to!... And for those believing let no one defraud you of it and drag you down to their level of unbelief, or be robbed of any promises you know Jesus gave you that are stored up for you in Heaven where your heart is! Many miss out on so much of the riches in Christ (which He wants you to have) all because of their lack of belief!*

*So then, to be Caught Up is to be Spirited Away. This may be a raised state of awakened mental and spiritual consciousness in unity/oneness with God, or this could be the transfiguring/translation of the body from this temporal reality to the Higher Spiritual Reality...or both... either or both is possible, for all things are possible with God, and scripture gives similar examples of God doing such. I choose not to let unbelief prevent me from entering into the DOOR of His REST... which a Faithful Believer can be Mentally Rested In while in the temporal body, and then Entered Into completely at the end of the Faithful Believer's temporal life, or by being Translated/Caught Up for those at the Last Trump.*

Romans 12:1&2

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Colossians 1:12&13

Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:

Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:

Hebrews 3:11-19

11 - So I swear in my wrath, They shall not enter into my rest.

12 - Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God.

13 - But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

14 - For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast unto the end;

15 - While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation.

16 - For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses.

17 - But with whom was he grieved forty years? was it not with them that had sinned, whose carcasses fell in the wilderness?

18 - And to whom sware he that they should not enter into his rest, but to them that believed not?

19 - So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.

#### Hebrews 4:1-13

1 - Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it.

2 - For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.

3 - For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.

4 - For he spake in a certain place of the seventh day on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works.

5 - And in this place again, If they shall enter into my rest.

6 - Seeing therefore it remaineth that some must enter therein, and they to whom it was first preached entered not in because of unbelief:

7 - Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts.

8 - For if Jesus had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day.

9 - There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God.

10 - For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his.

11 - Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.

12 - For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

13 - Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do.

#### Hebrews 6:11,12

11 - And we desire that every one of you do show the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end:

12 - That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

#### Hebrews 11:1-3,5,6,13-16,39-40

1 - Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

2 - For by it the elders obtained a good report.

3 - Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

5 - By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

6 - But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

13 - These all (*the elders*) died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

14 - For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country.

15 - And truly, if they had been mindful of that country from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned.

16 - But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city.

39 - And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise:

40 - God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.

Matthew 6:19-21

19 - Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:

20 - But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

21 - For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.
