Who is the Christ that true believers confess?... This is my declaration of Faith in Christ.

I have seen a few other believers in Christ who made a video declaring their Faith and I thought that is a wonderful idea that could work to Glorify our Lord and Savior, so here is mine...

This is what I will confess in word and deed, and what I am accountable to the Living God for,

... keeping the Essence of the WORD to fulfill His Commandments... is having <u>a love for the Living God</u> <u>through His Son Jesus, the Christ/Messiah, and love for your neighbor</u> (especially a brother in Christ), this is what is referred to as the Royal Law and the Spirit of the Law of Life...

and Jesus who is One with God the Father, and who is God from the fullness of the Eternal Spirit, and is the WORD of God who came in the flesh, and who was crucified and resurrected and returned to the fullness of the Eternal Spirit, made a New Covenant for His faithful followers which remain the flesh close to 2000 years ago, and which superseded the old Covenant "of works" through the performance of ordinances.

For His New Covenant is a Covenant "of Faith", being a better Covenant and Testament which is based on better Promises, and of greater power to purge the conscience from dead works to serve the living God, and now if I/you/we are saved by Christ's grace and live a changed life and turned away from sin, and living anew in His Spirit and in His Faith, He then has justified us which is imputed unto us for righteousness and we have peace with God, and so fulfilling His Commandments in this manner, and not by the works of the law being it's ordinances and precepts for justification, which Jesus abolished and done away with for those in His New Covenant - this is what really matters... if one lives anew in Spirit and in His Faith.

Yes we must confess the Faith... but not just confess with our mouths, we must confess with our actions which is the proof of what we believe, we must live it!

If you agree with this as a basic foundation of Christ, then I would say you are my brother or sister spiritually in Christ. You may express this a bit simpler or differently in your own words to declare your Faith in Christ but the foundational elements and meaning should always be the same. Do not be afraid to declare your Faith.

I also believe that in the Spirit of God/Holy Ghost we should be more focusing on the most important matters and issues that unify us in Christ's Love so we can spiritually grow without stumbling blocks to hinder us in His Faith and so providing space for growing unto greater Faith in respect for each other.

By doing so you will be Guiding Lights of the Spirit of Truth in Christ, and not as judges and enforcers to bring punishments upon sinners... it's obvious the "inquisitions" of the past were certainly manifestations of evil and not of the Spirit of God in Christ-likeness.

As far as what bible version I use... the Old King James Version is by far the best English version, but I also cross reference the KJV with Hebrew to English and Greek to English using "The Interlinear Bible", and Aramaic to English using the Peshitta New Testament Translation. Highly recommend these, get the actual source from which the English versions are translated, words in their original language can have deeper and richer in meaning, spiritually revealing more... The Holy Ghost guiding of course. I also use comparison references to see the differences of the many English versions.

If one cannot afford these in printed sources much can be found with online sources for free, it's not as hard as it used to be back in the days before the internet. We need to use it for the Glory of God for as long as we are able to.
